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Resolved Drug Shortages: Enlon (edrophonium chloride) injection and Enlon Plus (edrophonium chloride and atropine sulfate) injection, Bioniche Pharma has available the Enlon Plus 5 mL ampule (NDC 67457-0192-05) and the Enlon (NDC 67457-0190-15). The Enlon Plus multi- dose vials (NDC 67457-0191-15) are anticipated to be available soon.
